**VERIFIED JOINT PETITION  
TO MODIFY SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES**

Tipmont Rural Electric Membership Corporation (“Tipmont REMC”) and Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power (“CEL&P”) jointly petition the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (“IURC” or “Commission”) to approve their Agreement to modify service area boundaries located on U.S.G.S. Facet Map I-15-1 and J-15-1 in Montgomery County, Indiana, and state in support thereof:

1. Joint Petitioner, Tipmont REMC, is a Rural Electric Membership Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana, with its principal place of business located in Linden, Indiana. It is engaged in the business of distributing, furnishing, and selling retail electric service to the public in several counties in the State of Indiana, including Montgomery County, and has charter authority to do so.

2. Joint Petitioner, CEL&P, is a public utility organized and existing under the laws of the State of Indiana and has its principal office at 808 Lafayette Road, Crawfordsville, Indiana 47933. It is engaged in the business of distributing, furnishing, and selling retail electric service to the public in Montgomery County, and has charter authority to do so.

3. Each Joint Petitioner is an “electricity supplier” as such term is defined by Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-2(b) and the provisions of Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-1 *et seq.* are deemed applicable to the subject matter of this Joint Petition.

4. Pursuant to the Commission’s August 24, 1983 Final Order (“Final Order”) in Cause No. 36299-S217(X), the Commission established boundary lines between the Joint Petitioners on U.S.G.S. Facet Map I-15-1 and J-15-1 utilizing the modified mid-point between then existing electric distribution lines of the Joint Petitioners.

5. Portions of the boundary lines approved in said Final Order traversed through real estate in U.S.G.S. Facet Maps I-15-1 and J-15-1. Since that time, the Joint Petitioners have agreed that certain service territory modifications between Tipmont REMC and CEL&P have become necessary. The Joint Petitioners’ proposed modifications are shown on U.S.G.S. Facet Maps I-15-1 and J-15-1 and Exhibits A-1 through A-4 attached hereto.

6. Exhibit A-1, U.S.G.S. Facet Map I-15-1, identifies the first proposed boundary change as a red-outlined area. This change in service boundaries consists of CEL&P losing service territory and Tipmont REMC gaining service territory. A detailed map showing the proposed transferred territory at the parcel level is attached as Exhibit A-2.

7. Exhibit A-3, U.S.G.S. Facet Map J-15-1, identifies the second proposed boundary change as a red-outlined area. This change in service boundaries consists of Tipmont REMC losing service territory and CEL&P gaining service territory. A detailed map showing the proposed transferred territory at the parcel level is attached as Exhibit A-4.

8. Joint Petitioners are making this boundary modification to allow CEL&P to serve the property located at Parcel ID No. 54-07-28-700-042.002-028, as reflected on Exhibit A-4, more efficiently and at the customer’s request. The Joint Petitioners are also requesting the modification

to change the boundary line in the referenced area to follow a naturally occurring creek and to update the maps to reflect an annexed parcel that CEL&P is already serving south of the parcel requesting service from CEL&P. In exchange, Tipmont REMC is receiving the opportunity to serve the property located at Parcel ID No. 54-07-19-500-007.000-024, which is adjacent to a current service location of Tipmont REMC at Parcel ID No. 54-07-19-500-007.001-024, as reflected on Exhibit A-2.

9. The requested proposed modifications will not cause duplication of facilities, a waste of materials or resources, or uneconomic, inefficient, or inadequate electric service to the public, all as required by Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(2).

10. The Commission has jurisdiction of this action pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(a)(2).

13. In accordance with amended Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6, Joint Petitioners will publish notice of these changes, in a newspaper of general circulation in Montgomery County, Indiana. See Exhibit B for a copy of the Notice. Further in accordance with 170 IAC 1-1.1-9, Tipmont REMC will post the Legal Notice on its Company website located at <https://connect.tipmont.org/categories/electric/notice-of-electric-service-territory-change>, and CEL&P will post the Legal Notice on its Company website located at <https://celp.com/news/> where each Legal Notice will remain for at least thirty (30) days following a Final Order in this cause of action.

14. Also pursuant to 170 IAC 1-1.1-9, Joint Petitioners hereby provide notice to this Commission that the Parties reasonably anticipated to participate in this proceeding, CEL&P, Tipmont REMC and the Office of Utility Consumer Counselor (“OUCC”), are in agreement with the following Proposed Procedural Schedule:

16. The Joint Petitioners agree to work with the Commission staff to update the Commission GIS maps, in accordance with any approval of boundary changes.

17. The requested boundary changes will not cause the service supplier to change for any existing customer.

WHEREFORE, Joint Petitioners, CEL&P and Tipmont REMC, respectfully request that the Commission, pursuant to Ind. Code § 8-1-2.3-6(a)(2), after twenty (20) days and if no affected electricity customer requests a hearing, enter an Order in this proceeding, without a hearing, permanently approving the changes to the service area boundaries on U.S.G.S. Facet Map I-15-1 and J-15-1, as identified on Exhibits A-1 through A-4 and as proposed in this Joint Petition.



# Transfer between Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power and Tipmont REMC



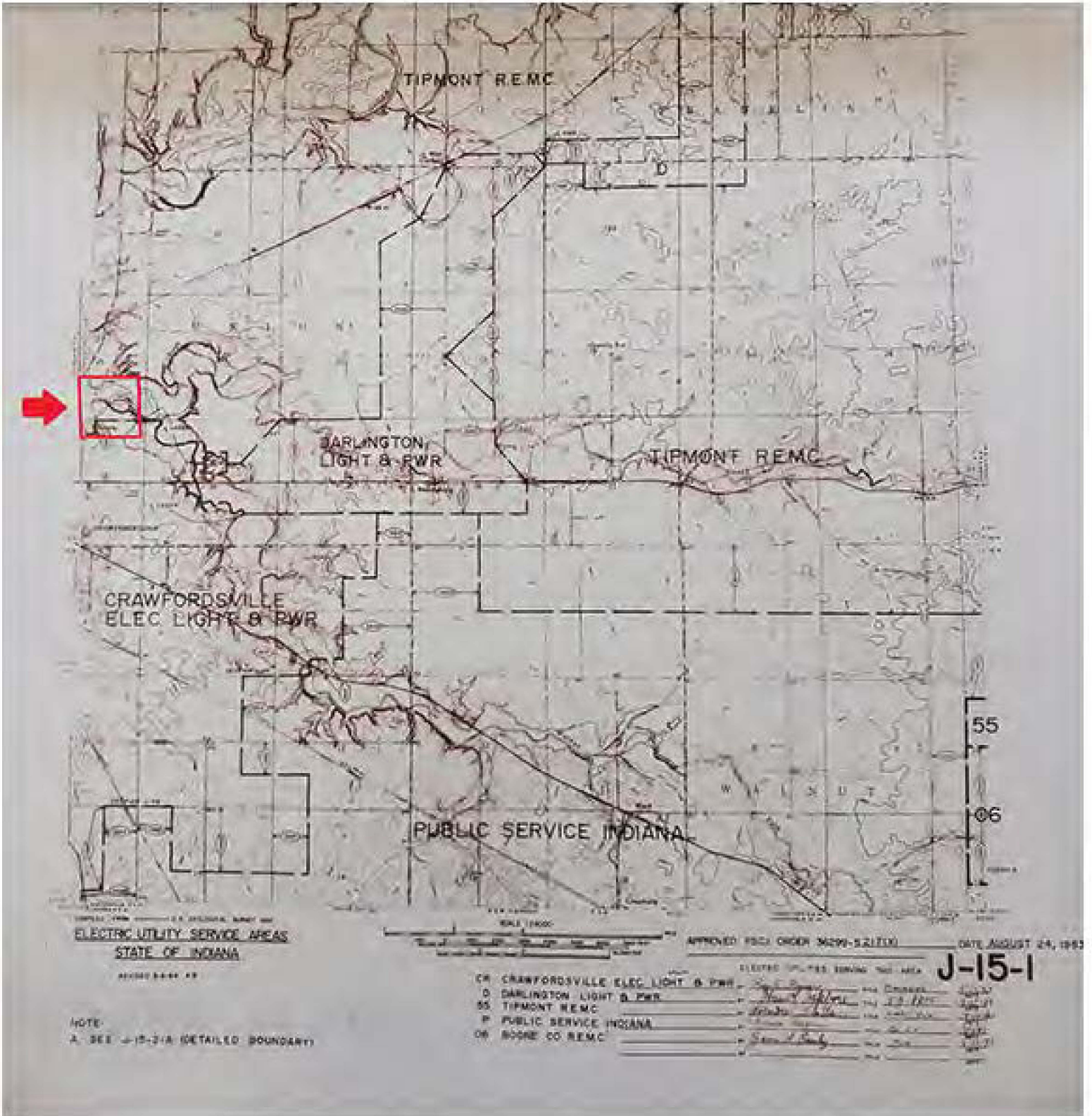
Lot Boundaries

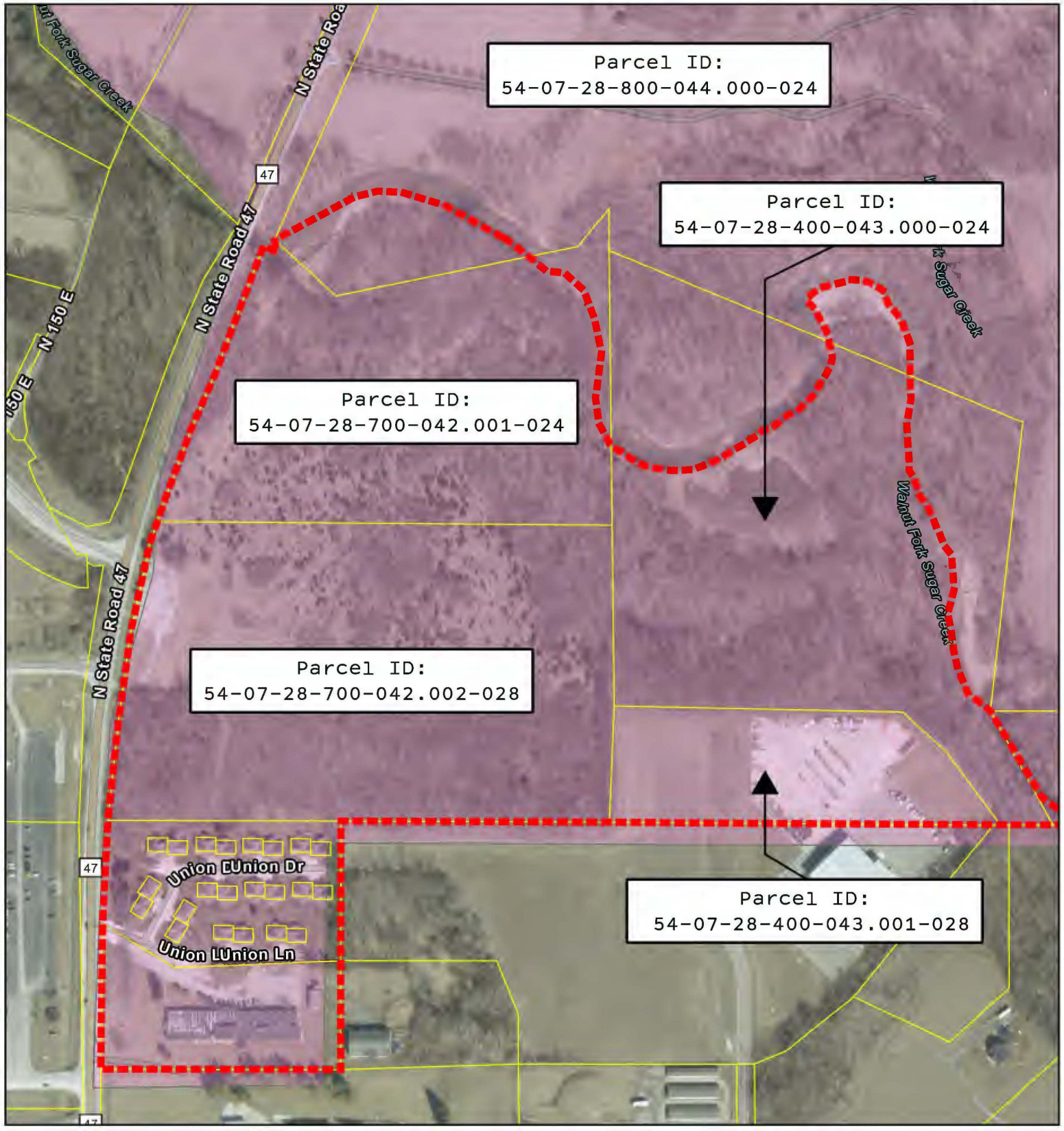

Tipmont Rural Electric Membership Corporation (“Tipmont REMC”) and Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power (“CEL&P”) hereby give notice that on June 5, 2026, a Joint Petition was filed with the Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission for approval to modify service area boundaries between Tipmont REMC and CEL&P associated with areas located in Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 4 West, situated between Industrial Drive and County Road 100 West near Crawfordsville Indiana, located on U.S.G.S.
